- Change is budget neutral and will utilize existing resources within the institute.






DMD – Proposed Responsibilities

- Plans, develops, supports and manages the medications development program to treat alcohol use disorder
- Develop and standardize preclinical and clinical laboratory screening models to test promising medications
- Advance personalized medicine to predict favorable responses to specific medications
- Advises the NIAAA Director on advances in drug development and coordinates program to establish institute objectives






Existing NIAAA Organizational Structure
